B 1:38 - 2:08

Repeat motions described in Section B.

C 2:08 - 2:26

Face centre, crouch down on one knee and sequentially bring arms from behind over shoulders onto rail; (8)
As a group, slowly lift rail line back into standing position; (8)

Right hand turn partner, palm to palm; (8) Left hand turn partner, palm to palm; (8)

Take hands and *circle left*, 1,2,3, stomp, 1,2,3, stomp; (8)
Step towards centre, connect hands above head, lower all hands into centre of circle (4)
Snap up head after rest, slowly rise and raise and open arms and hands above head
